<b>Regional Taekwondo Qualification Tournaments</b>	48 places for men and 48 places for women will be attributed at the Regional Qualification Tournaments as follows:  <b>Africa:</b> 2 men and 2 women per weight category (8 men and 8 women in total) <b>Asia:</b> 3 men and 3 women per weight category (12 men and 12 women in total) <b>Europe:</b> 3 men and 3 women per weight category (12 men and 12 women) <b>Oceania:</b> 1 man and 1 woman per weight category (4 men and 4 women) <b>Pan America:</b> 3 men and 3 women per weight category (12 men and 12 women in total)	Men: 48 Women: 48
<b>Tripartite Commission Invitation</b>	4 places will be allocated by the Tripartite Commission (gender not previously defined)	4
