Those who are not recognized as adults by law in their own country must submit a written consent of their parents or lawful guardian accepting the participation and all parts of the official invitation (liability waiver)

General Information regarding the form specifications:

Every running Poomsae will be drawn by lot.
In each competition, 4 different Poomsae will be run.
Achieved points from the rounds before, will not count to the new run.
The Poomsae runs will be defined obligatory for all categories by the competition coordinators.

In the 1st round one form of the compulsory 1 will be presented.
In the 2nd round one form of the compulsory 2 will be presented.
In the 3rd round one form of the compulsory 2 will be presented.
After that (starting no later than 1 minute after the end of the first poomsae) the athlete has to start with the form of compulsory 2.
Delays will lead to sanctions subtracting points. The Finalforms have to be presented in the same order as they were drawn.

By deuce after the final round a play-off is necessary. You must run the form of the drawn 1st round.

The Team Competitors can only start in the respectively age category

Scoring: Places 1-3 will be scored for classification of clubs and countries.
The formula 6-3-1 will be used.
(Reported teams of the German country associations (state divisions) will only be recognized in the country-score.

Award presentation: Trophy for place 1 in the individual score,
Medals for places 2 - 3 in the individual score,
Trophies for places 1 - 5 for clubs,
Trophies for places 1 - 3 for countries,
Trophies for talent for female and male juniors.
