



ETU Announces New Committee Appointments

Strengthening leadership, expertise, and governance across European Taekwondo

The European Taekwondo Union (ETU) is pleased to announce the appointment of its new committees, marking an important step in strengthening the organisation's governance, technical development, and strategic direction across Europe.

The appointments follow a comprehensive selection process led by the Ad Hoc Nominations Committee, chaired by Dr Said Khelwatty, and conducted in accordance with ETU Statutes and governance principles.

A robust and transparent appointment process

The call for applications attracted strong interest from across the European Taekwondo community, demonstrating the commitment of many individuals to support the future development of the sport.

Each application was carefully reviewed through a structured process which included:

- Assessment of candidates' experience, qualifications, and expertise
- Review of submitted CVs and supporting information
- Consideration of suitability for the specific remit of each committee
- Evaluation of balance, diversity, and overall committee composition
- Consultation with Member National Associations (MNAs), where appropriate

Following this detailed review, the Nominations Committee submitted its recommendations to the ETU President for final approval.

Appointments made on merit and suitability

All appointments have been approved by the ETU President based on the recommendations of the Nominations Committee, ensuring that selections are rooted in merit, capability, and the needs of each committee.



ETU President Sakis Pragalos said:
